Sunday's Reading

Numbers 22: 22 - 35

Balaam and his Donkey Meet an Angel

²² But God was very angry when he went, and the angel of the LORD stood in the road to oppose him. Balaam was riding on his donkey, and his two servants were with him. ²³ When the donkey saw the angel of the LORD standing in the road with a drawn sword in his hand, it turned off the road into a field. Balaam beat it to get it back on the road.

²⁴ Then the angel of the LORD stood in a narrow path through the vineyards, with walls on both sides. ²⁵ When the donkey saw the angel of the LORD, it pressed close to the wall, crushing Balaam's foot against it. So he beat the donkey again.

²⁶ Then the angel of the LORD moved on ahead and stood in a narrow place where there was no room to turn, either to the right or to the left. ²⁷ When the donkey saw the angel of the LORD, it lay down under Balaam, and he was angry and beat it with his staff. ²⁸ Then the LORD opened the donkey's mouth, and it said to Balaam, "What have I done to you to make you beat me these three times?"

²⁹ Balaam answered the donkey, "You have made a fool of me! If only I had a sword in my hand, I would kill you right now."

³⁰ The donkey said to Balaam, "Am I not your own donkey, which you have always ridden, to this day? Have I been in the habit of doing this to you?"

"No," he said.



³¹Then the LORD opened Balaam's eyes, and he saw the angel of the LORD standing in the road with his sword drawn. So he bowed low and fell facedown.

³² The angel of the LORD asked him, "Why have you beaten your donkey these three times? I have come here to oppose you because your path is a reckless one before me.^{[a] 33} The donkey saw me and turned away from me these three times. If it had not turned away, I would certainly have killed you by now, but I would have spared it."

³⁴ Balaam said to the angel of the LORD, "I have sinned. I did not realize you were standing in the road to oppose me. Now if you are displeased, I will go back."

³⁵ The angel of the LORD said to Balaam, "Go with the men, but speak only what I tell you." So Balaam went with Balak's officials.

The Arts Society Crosby will hold its next meeting in the church hall at 2.00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 11th. Michael Howard, an artist and Fellow of the RSA, will give an illustrated talk entitled `David Hockney: A Certain Generosity of Spirit'.

Saltmine Theatre Company is a professional touring theatre company with a Christian ethos (<u>www.saltminetrust.org.uk</u>). We tour into churches, schools and theatres around the UK. Theatre in Education is a key part of what we do, and each year we work with about 300 primary and secondary schools and perform to over 54,000 students.

Saltmine Theatre Company has been booked to tour our anti-knife crime production *Switch Up* into St Michael's High School in September and we are looking for Christian hosts in the area for our team of actors the night before they go into the school.

Here are the details:

Can you host a Christian actor?

WHEN: evening of Thursday 26th September

WHO: team is made up of one female, four males (the team, all Christians in their 20s-30s, have their own transport and don't have to stay together). All of them are tall, so will need adult beds, not children's beds (sorry if this sounds obvious).

WHAT'S REQUESTED: we ask hosts to provide a bed for the night and breakfast (breakfast usually being something to 'grab and go' early in the morning before they head to school, they usually need to be at school for around 7am). IF hosts wish to offer an evening meal on Thursday 26th to bless their Saltmine guests this will be greatly appreciated but it is not obligatory - we don't want to impose.

As a Christian charity we cannot afford to pay for hospitality. People who are willing to host really are making an invaluable contribution to our ministry
